This website uses cookies. Cookies are small text files stored on your computer within your web browser. We use these cookies for a variety of reasons, including monitoring website activity to improve your experience.

Below are details of some of the types of cookies we use.

Strictly Necessary Cookies

We use some cookies that are strictly necessary for the site to work correctly and enable certain features. You cannot disable these cookies, but they do not contain any personal or intrusive information. For example, we use cookies to monitor your shopping cart and keep track of the items you add before you go to the checkout to purchase. We also use cookies to allow you to use our live chat feature.

Performance Cookies

These cookies help us improve the performance of the website, providing a better user experience, by letting us monitor how visitors use the website and how they found it. These cookies are anonymous and do not contain any personally identifiable information.

Online Behavioural Advertising Cookies

We use the services of a third-party advertising platform and may place cookies that allow them to provide you with more tailored adverts when browsing other websites on the internet.

Other Services' Third Party Cookies

We use social sharing and video services run by other companies. These companies may drop cookies on your computer when you use them on our site, or if you are already logged in to them.
